### USE RATES

Use **TRI-CARD CONCENTRATED DEFOAMER** at 1 to 2 ounces per 100 gallons of solution. It may be necessary to adjust the amount used according to individual conditions.

**NOTE:** It is always best to add to tank mixture before foam has already formed.

### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

**Keep from freezing.** Store in a cool dry place. Do not reuse empty container. Dispose of container in a safe manner in accordance with federal, state and local regulations. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

### FIRST AID

**If Ingested:** Get medical attention immediately. Do not induce vomiting, except by physician's order.
