### GENERAL INFORMATION

**D-W SURFACTANT** is a water soluble spreader-wetter non-ionic type surfactant designed for use in improving wetting and deposition of pesticide spray on leaf surfaces. **D-W SURFACTANT** decreases the surface tension of the spray allowing for increased spreading and more uniform coverage on leaf and stem surfaces.

### RECOMMENDED RATES

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

**D-W SURFACTANT** can be used with agricultural, industrial, forestry, aquatic and turf products that recommends a wetter-spreader type adjuvant. Add pesticides and other related products to the spray mixture before adding **D-W SURFACTANT**.

**NOTE:** Always follow pesticide label recommendations.

### FIRST AID

**Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice.**

**If Swallowed:** Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

**If on Skin or Clothing:** Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes.

**If Inhaled:** Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth to mouth if possible.

**If in Eyes:** Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Have the product container with you when calling a poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment.

### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not store near heat or open flame. Store in original container. Do not reuse empty container. Triple rinse (or equivalent) into spray tank then dispose of or recondition container through the regulations set by local and state authorities.
