DIRECTIONS FOR USE

1. Fill cotton picker tank at least one-half full of water.

- 2. Agitate the water by operating the precision moistener control water system. This will recirculate the water back through the supply tank.
- 3. While the water is agitating, slowly add the **SPINDLE SLICK** to the water at a ratio of 10-20 oz. per 100 gallons of cleaner solution.
- Finish filling tank with water while agitating continues. After tank is filled, allow agitation to continue for approximately five minutes.
