$$\text{Pond Length (ft)} \times \text{Pond Width (ft)} \times \text{Average Depth (ft)} = \text{Acre-Feet of Water } 43,560 \text{ ft}^2$$

After calculating the acre/feet of water, pour the appropriate quantity of dye into the water along the edge of the lake or pond. **TRI-CARD STRIKEOUT** will diffuse evenly, dispersing with lake and pond currents and normal water movement. To assist diffusion throughout the entire lake or pond,

empty the gallon container(s) at different points around the lake or pond edge or through an aerator, circulation or injection system, waterfall or fountain. Wear eye protection and rubber gloves, carefully applying the dye directly to the water.
